If a non member is in any of the placings those points will not be allocated and will be known as 'Throw Away Points'.

Unaffiliated Qualifying Criteria

In 2017 there are 6 Unaffiliated Showjumping League competitions scheduled. Competitors wishing to compete for an overall position at the end of the year in this discipline must be Codham Park Members and must have attended 4 out of 6 rounds to qualify, In the Unaffiliated Dressage, Members must have attended 3 out of 4 rounds to qualify. For JumpCross, Please see below.

British Showjumping

This season we have been awarded the Senior Nupafeed Discovery 2nd Round along with The National Team Qualifier for Scope on Sun 7th May 17. Last year we introduced the Codham Park 1.10 Qualifier at each Senior BS show we held, this year we plan to add the 1.20m too, for our Great Championship Show to be held on Sat 30th Sept 17. Full details on qualifying will be published once approved by British Showjumping. We have secured more Scope Qualifiers, 95cm Open, tacklockers 1m & Buckaroo 1.05m on Sunday 16th April Which is also our BS easter Show, with lots of yummy Easter Eggs. Again we will be Holding the NSEA JWS Arena eventing Championship qualifier on Thurs 6th April 17, this proved to be very popular & we hope to be adding New exciting Fences, especially for this event.

British Dressage

We are delighted to have been approached by BritishDressage to host a first round Area Festival. The qualifier is the weekend commencing 17 June; take a look at britishdressage.co.uk for further details.

Arena Eventing

Following the success of Arena Eventing in 2016 we shall be hosting this again in 2017. Investment will be made into even more rustic fences for your enjoyment. We currently have three Arena Eventing dates listed for 2017; 23rd April, 30th July and 20th August.

JumpCross Update!

We have a new and improved JumpCross course for 2017!

Changes include a new water feature, a new woodland area and a sand pit feature. Dust off your cross country colours and get ready for an entirely different experience in 2017.

Whilst the new water feature will not be incorporated into the low level classes on competition days, individuals are welcome (and actively encouraged) to come to training days to give it a go.

JumpCross Marshalls

Now that the course is bigger and better than ever we are appealing for JumpCross Marshalls for the coming year. You need no prior experience and will not be expected to score the course (although if you are near a jump which has been knocked you may need to put the pole back up). If you are aged 16 or over, with a common sense approach and able to take direction from the friendly team at Codham we'd love to hear from you.

In return for your assistance you'll be well fed and watered throughout the day and be given arena hire vouchers or paid if preferred.

JumpCross Membership

Just a reminder that for both JumpCross training and competition days you need to contact JumpCross in Peterborough, either online or by telephone, for either day membership or annual membership before entering; we cannot unfortunately accept your entry if you have not obtained the requisite membership from JumpCross as we require your JumpCross membership number before being able to process your entry and this is entirely separate to your Codham Park membership.

JumpCross Attendance

In 2017 there are 5 JumpCross competitions scheduled. Competitors wishing to compete for an overall position at the end of the year in this discipline must be Codham Park Members and must have attended 4 out of 5 rounds to qualify.

In the event of the number competitive rounds reducing due to reasons outside of the venue's control (e.g. safety reasons, weather conditions) competitors will in any event be expected to miss no more than 1 competitive round in order to qualify for the final league.

JumpCross Dress Code

Riding hats are to conform to current Safety standards PAS015, EN1384 and no one is to ride with a fixed peak. Body protectors and medical cards must be worn at all times for both training and competitions.

JumpCross Scoring

Scoring of JumpCross rounds remains the same, with the lowest final time (including the added or subtracted seconds below) dictating overall position:

Knock down – 20 seconds added to your time for each knock down

Refusal – 50 seconds added to your time for each refusal (2 refusals and you must move onto the next fence)

Knock down of Joker Fence – 40 seconds added to your time

Clearance of Joker Fence – 40 seconds taken off your time

Rider Fall – Elimination

Horse Fall – Elimination

Exceeding venue's allowed course time – may result in elimination to enable the smooth running of the event
