CLASS 1 Nupafeed Supplements Senior Discovery First Round/1m Open

RULE 314. SINGLE PHASE. SPEED 325MPM. START HEIGHT 1.00M.

Horses / ponies may only compete in one section.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Discovery:

a) For Horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 225 points.

4 Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 314.6.

b) For all horses born on or after 1 January 2013 irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of five years or under in the same calendar year as the Discovery Final - in accordance with Rule 314.6.

Qualifies for: Nupafeed Supplements Discovery Championship Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horses that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four First Round competitions held in any qualifying period, will qualify to compete in and attend four Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification.

1.00m Open:

For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

If combined with an open:

In Category 2 Shows the sections must always be split with two sets of prize money awarded, irrespective of starters.

Newcomers:

(a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 375 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 312.6

(b) For all horses born on or after 1st January 2012, irrespective of Points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of six years or under in the same calendar year as the Newcomers Final - in accordance with Rule 312.6.

Four double clears will qualify for the Senior Newcomers Second Rounds. Qualifying period 1st June - 31st May inclusive.

1.10m Open: For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

CLASS 3 Equitop Myoplast Senior Foxhunter First Round / 1.20m Open

RULE 310. SINGLE PHASE. SPEED 350MPM. START HEIGHT 1.20M.

First place rosette kindly sponsored by Equitop Myoplast In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses / ponies may only compete in one section.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Foxhunter section:

(a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 700 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 310.6

(b) For all registered horses born on or after 1 January 2011, irrespective of points. Horses will be eligible for double clear qualification to attend second rounds providing they reach the age of seven years or under in the same calendar year as the Foxhunter Final - in accordance with rule 310.6 Four double clears will qualify.

Four Double clears will qualify for the Senior Foxhunter Second Rounds. Qualifying period: 1st June-31st May inclusive.

Those horses that have qualified for the Senior Foxhunter Championship in 2017 are not eligible for qualification to the 2018 Championship. Open section: For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

Numbers to qualify: Two double clears to qualify. Double clear qualifications will not be obtained from competitions comprised of a single round.

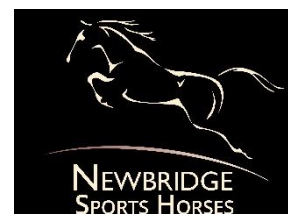

For registered horses, aged 6 years old at the 1st January of the qualifying year to be ridden by Adult, Associate and Junior Members.

BREEDING PAPERS ARE MANDATORY AND MUST BE LODGED AND APPROVED BY BRITISH SHOWJUMPING AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION.

Qualifies for: Big Star Championship at the British Showjumping National Championships.

Numbers to qualify: All treble clears.

Course

9-11 fences, one double combination and/or treble combination.

Water jump with two poles jumped going towards home and if followed by another fence not less than six strides.

Not judged as water jump.

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling

The total maximum weight of equipment allowed to be added to a horse's leg; front or hind (single or multiple boots, fetlock rings etc), is 500g.

All hind leg protections must have a maximum interior length of 16cm and a minimum exterior width of 5cm.

The inside protection must be smooth and the fixations must be made of non-elastic Velcro type fasteners with no hooks or straps permitted.

The rounded rigid part of the protection must be placed around the inside of the fetlock. No additional elements may be used in conjunction with the protection.

Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Rule 290.15 - Pre-Entry Drawn Order

Pre-entries may possibly be accepted before 9.00am providing that the number of entries are less than 60 (with the exception of County shows). Once entries reach 60 before 9.00am the class will be closed. Any entries taken on the day must compete first in the drawn order.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Foxhunter section:

(a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 700 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 310.6

(b) For all registered horses born on or after 1 January 2011, irrespective of points. Horses will be eligible for double clear qualification to attend second rounds providing they reach the age of seven years or under in the same calendar year as the Foxhunter Final - in accordance with rule 310.6 Four double clears will qualify.

Four Double clears will qualify for the Senior Foxhunter Second Rounds. Qualifying period: 1st June-31st May inclusive.

Those horses that have qualified for the Senior Foxhunter Championship in 2017 are not eligible for qualification to the 2018 Championship. Open section: For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

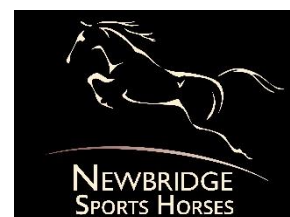

Qualifying period: 1st July - 30th June

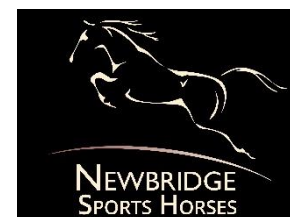

No Lunging in the arenas at any time, please ask for permission to do so on the open grass area.

No misuse of training aids whatsoever

All dogs must be kept on leads and cleaned up after. No smoking in the arena areas. All children under the age of 16 years must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times. All rubbish/litter to be removed from site or placed in bins provided. Please do not muck out your lorry in the lorry park.

In the event of any rider travelling to a show on their own, details of an emergency contact should be left with the secretary in case of an accident.

Cars / Lorries are parked in car park at owners own risk

Please only pick up your droppings in the warm-up arena if safe to do so and placed in the bins provided.

Judges decision is FINAL; conduct must not be offensive to any show official.

Hard hats to current BS VG1, PAS 015 or SEI ASTM F1163 04a Onwards, SNELL E2001 AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards must be worn & correctly secured whilst mounted.

No competitor / rider shall allow a stallion for which they are responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure competitors, officials or other members of the public are not put at risk of injury, Stallions must display a ribbon in the tail and be lead from the bit at all times.

No refunds will be given once classes are entered.

Any person who fails to comply with these terms & conditions will be liable to forfeit their fees & expulsion from site.

Entries can be paid online or paid on the day, We No longer accept cheques as a form of payment, Credit / Debit cards will have an additional £1.00 admin charge per transaction.

Codham Park Equestrian reserve the right to cancel, add to or amend any of the Competitions as they see fit due to weather conditions etc.

Junior riders can ride horses the beginning of the calendar year in which the age of 12 is reached.

From Colchester: leave Colchester on the A120 towards Braintree turn right on the roundabout to join the A131 towards Halstead/Sudbury, next roundabout turn left onto the B1053 Broad Rd, turn right at second mini roundabout into Church Lane (by Braintree College) continue on until the road name changes into Church Street, go over bridge then turn left onto the Bovingdon Road, keep on this road till you come to a S bend (left & right corner) go downhill then turn left at industrial access sign into Codham Park Drive. From Halstead/Gosfield: Turn off A1017 Hedingham/Braintree Road at Oak tree in Gosfield (Nr Kings Head Pub) into Church Road, follow onto Park Hall Road, turn left at junction on entering Beazley End, drop down hill and turn right at industrial access sign into Codham Park Drive. N: 51° 55.832', E: 0° 31.813'

From Chelmsford & M11: Please avoid the town centre by taking the A120 bypass towards Halstead/Sudbury A131, next roundabout turn left onto the B1053 Broad Rd, turn right at second mini roundabout into Church Lane (by Braintree College) continue on until the road name changes into Church Street, go over bridge then turn left onto the Bovingdon Road, keep on this road till you come to a S bend (left & right corner) go downhill then turn left at industrial access sign into Codham Park Drive.
