They know that as soon as the word "equestrian" gets mentioned in any context the price of anything immediately doubles! They like to think they are good at sourcing products for equestrians at realistic, affordable prices along with correct advice to go with it!

Solutions both rider and horse can count on for quality and clarity.

Lighting is partly provided to enable the safe movement of both horses and rider appropriate to the standard of participation. The action of both must be clearly seen by spectators, officials, and trainers. The lighting installation should provide even illumination over the total floor area. Shadows should be avoided as these may cause horses to shy. Most purpose-built arenas are rectangular in design, although the overall dimensions may vary considerably. The smallest arena size for dressage test is 20mt x 40mt. Any arena around the 60m x 20m is more widely accepted.

The eye level of a rider is typically between 2mt and 2.5mt above ground level and may significantly increase when jumps are taken. This should be considered when determining a suitable mounting height for lights. Glare to both horse and rider should be limited as much as possible.

The lighting must be adequate to enable the safe progress of both horse and rider over the jumps and to discern the finer points of dressage, it is important that a high degree of lighting uniformity is achieved with sufficient floodlighting positions to remove shadowing around show jumping fences.

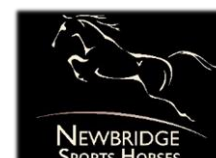

New Year / New Rules / New Points Structure

You have a much better chance of being crowned Codham Park's 2022 Overall Leading Horse or Pony Member if you compete in as many disciplines as you can and as often as you can as points are tallied across the board. The qualifying disciplines are:
Showjumping - Dressage - JumpCross - Arena Eventing - Arena X-Country

The two topmost scores from each discipline on any given day will be used towards calculating your overall ranking.

New Members' Unaffiliated League Points Scoring Structure

2019 saw the start of our British Showjumping 90cm Protexin Equine League, the points scoring system was a complete winner, so we have tweaked the system and decided to carry the Point allocation system over to the Unaffiliated member Leagues, below is an example of how points will now be awarded.

Whether you are in the Top 6 placings or not for League Showjumping / Arena Eventing / Arena X-Country / Dressage & JumpCross points will be awarded down the line, unless eliminated, whereas No points will be given.

Watch Out for Double Header Points Shows!

Unaffiliated Leagues - Qualifying Attendance Criteria in 2022

JumpCross League Attendance Requirement

In 2022 there are 4 JumpCross competitions scheduled. Competitors wishing to compete for an overall league position at the end of the year in this discipline must be **Codham Park Members** and must attend all rounds to qualify.

Water Splashes

For the forthcoming year some of the water features will continue to be optional and competitors have the option of going through the water or bypassing via the white and red posts as an alternative.

JumpCross Scoring

Scoring of JumpCross rounds remains the same, with the lowest final time (including the added or subtracted seconds below) dictating overall position:

Knock down	20 seconds added to your time for each knock down
Refusal	50 seconds added to your time for each refusal (2 refusals and you must move onto the next fence) (Maximum 6 refusals incurs Elimination)
Knock down of Joker Fence	40 seconds added to your time
Clearance of Joker Fence	40 seconds taken off your time
Rider Fall or Horse Fall	Elimination
Exceeding venue's allowed course time	May result in elimination to enable smooth running of the competition

Dressage

2022 will continue the popular 2 day shows My Quest Team Quest / Unaffiliated Dressage and British Dressage. The unaffiliated schedule format will remain as per 2021, all unaffiliated riders “Do Not Panic” all your classes and League points will remain the same and will incorporate Sunshine Tour Qualifiers  **SUNSHINE TOUR**

BD introduced competitions for riders of all ages and abilities called ‘MyQuest’ and ‘TeamQuest’. Riders will be at Intro, Prelim and Novice level and can take part in fun and relaxed dressage competitions. There are two age categories; ‘Under 21’ (up to the end of the year of their 21st birthday) and ‘Open’. Under MyQuest riders compete alone and under TeamQuest teams of three or four riders will ride as individuals across any of the three test levels and the best three scores count towards an overall team total, with the highest team total winning the competition. MyQuest riders and TeamQuest riders will be awarded points based on the best placings and will be ranked on a regional leaderboard which then takes top riders and teams forward to a Regional and then National Final. In order to compete via MyQuest or TeamQuest riders must have a minimum club membership through British Dressage and a minimum club registration for horses through British Dressage.

Whilst the introduction of MyQuest and TeamQuest is aimed at enhancing options available to our competitors, there is no obligation to participate and **those happy and wishing to compete at unaffiliated level are welcome to do so.**
